We want to keep the congregation informed as to our progress of the 2020 stewardship financial campaign.

The re-cap as of December 15, 2019 shows we have received pledges from 40 families. That is about 15% behind last year results for the same time period. Obviously, with fewer pledges than last year, the giving to date is also below last year. We will be sending out letters with pledge cards in late December to those who have not had the opportunity to respond with a pledge yet.

We expect approximately 105 giving families in 2020. As you can imagine, coming up with a balanced budget for 2020 with only about 50% pledges and estimating the remainder of giving, makes the task difficult

(Your people. How do I know who they are?)


